Grand Valley Power Scholarship

The Grand Valley Power Scholarship is created to promote the educational pursuits of students in Grand Valley Power's service territory and expand the educational opportunities available to them.

Scholarships are granted for use at accredited colleges, universities and vocational schools for undergraduate education and technical and trade programs with at least a one-year course of study toward a degree or certificate.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must:

- Submit all the required information on the application,
- Enroll full-time (min. 12 credit hours per semester or quarter),
- Be currently residing in a home served by Grand Valley Power.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applications must be made on forms supplied by Grand Valley Power and must include:

1. Official transcript from the last high school or college attended.
2. Two letters of recommendation from non-relatives.
3. A written essay on why the applicant should be awarded a Grand Valley Power Scholarship. The applicant should discuss such items as school and community involvement, volunteer experience, leadership and work opportunities as well as financial need and future plans.
4. A photo of the applicant is to be included with the application.

Applications must be postmarked or submitted online at gvp.org by March 1, 2024.

AWARDS

Six (6) \$1,500 scholarships will be granted to applicants in 2024.

Scholarship winners are required to attend their school's senior awards event (if applicable) and Grand Valley Power's annual membership meeting on August 8, 2024 to be recognized.

Awards may be used to cover any of the following costs at accredited colleges, universities and vocational schools:

- * Tuition costs.
- * On-campus room and board expenses during the academic year only.
- * Appropriate allowances for books and fees.

The Grand Valley Power Scholarship may be combined with other scholarships, grants and awards.

This scholarship is not renewable. **Applicants can only receive one GVP scholarship per lifetime. Applicants are not eligible to receive multiple scholarships in a year issued by Grand Valley Power.**

A committee of educators appointed by the board of directors will review all applications received by the due date and select an awardee, who will be notified by mail and/or email by April 1, 2024.

All decisions by Grand Valley Power are final.
