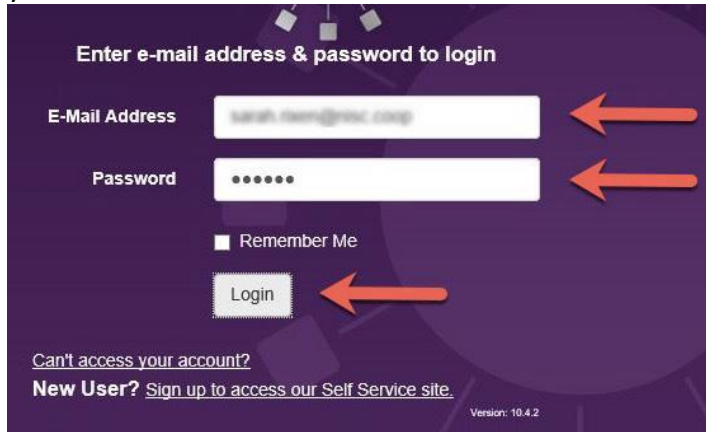




Step 1: From the SmartHub login screen, sign into your GVP account.

Step 3: You have a variety of ways to view your usage. The most common way is to start at “Usage Explorer”. Here you can view your meter data monthly, daily or hourly. You can also pick a date range or certain dates, in addition to showing the current temperature during that timeframe.

The Budget Gauge tool allows you to set and track a monthly target to help avoid unexpected high utility bills.

By setting your usage budget, you can quickly track how you are trending towards that goal.

With the **Usage Planning** tool, create markers for a point in time to help you keep track of the differences in your usage. For example, set an energy marker to find out the change in your usage after installing a new water heater or upgrading an appliance. Download your data using the "Green Button".

Green Button is a national, government-led initiative that gives customers easy and secure access to their personal energy use data. Information you will be able to view with your usage data includes a summary of your electricity usage over the time frame you specify when downloading your usage - up to 14 months.
