Time of Use Farm and Home

Availability:

Available to consumers qualifying for service under Farm and Home Service, Schedule FH-1. Subject to the established rules and regulations of the Seller.

Applicability:

To all consumers served by the cooperative.

Type of Service:

Single phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltages.

Rate:

Distribution Charges:

Grid Connectivity Charge:	\$26.00 per meter per month
Energy Delivery Charge:	All kWh per month @ \$0.02580 per kWh

Generation and Transmission Charges:

Power Supply Energy On-Peak:	All kWh per month @ \$0.16783 per kWh
Power Supply Energy Off-Peak:	All kWh per month @ \$0.03357 per kWh

In addition to the rates and charges described above, a Wholesale Power Cost Adjustment (WPCA) shall be applied to all kWh billed.

On-Peak Period:

Summer: Between the hours of 12:30 p.m. – 10:30 p.m., Sunday through Friday, May through September

Winter: Between the hours of 6:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. - 10:00 p.m., Sunday through Friday, October through April

Off-Peak Period:

Summer: Between the hours of 10:30 p.m. – 12:30 p.m., Sunday through Friday and all day Saturday, May through September

Winter: Between the hours of 11:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. - 6:30 a.m.,
Sunday through Friday and all day Saturday, October through April

All energy used on the holidays of Thanksgiving and Christmas will be charged at the off-peak rate regardless of the day of the week upon which the holiday occurs.

This time of use rate is voluntary and shall begin upon installation of the time of use meter. If the consumer requests to be converted back to the standard rate, the standard rate will begin upon installation of the standard meter.
